

LESSON SCHEDULE & PAYMENT AGREEMENT

SCHEDULING:

Lesson sessions are scheduled seasonally in 12 week sessions. Each session is scheduled approximately 2 weeks prior to the start time. Start times are approximate, however, you are expected to attend the **entire session** once you have committed and are scheduled. They are as follows:

Spring	-	April 1 st – June 15 th
Summer	-	June 15 th – September 1 st
Fall	-	September 1 st – December 15 th
Winter	-	December 15 th – April 1 st

PAYMENT & ATTENDANCE:

Private lesson cost is \$50 per hour

Group lessons cost is \$30 per lesson or \$100 paid in advance for 4 weeks.

Mileage cost will be calculated in addition to the above prices when traveling to off-site lessons.

When you opt for the pay in advance option, you understand that if a lesson is missed and not made up within the same week, your money for that lesson is non-refundable and forfeited for that week. The only exception for this would be in the case of inclement weather and then we will roll that payment week over to the end of the four weeks. (However, we will first try to make every attempt to reschedule for the same week). There will be **NO EXCEPTIONS** with missed lessons in this payment plan (including, but not limited to sickness, accidents, doctor's appts, vacations, school trips, etc) so please choose your payment method carefully. You may change your payment method within a session to accommodate your schedule. This, however, must be done only after a 4 week pay in advance session is completed.

Horsemanship is simple but it is not easy. It is very important that each student (and parent if applicable) is committed to the learning experience. Missed lessons hinder this process. I expect a level of commitment and strongly recommend that lessons are regularly attended. Homework will be occasionally assigned. Once a student is capable and comfortable, they may be asked to come early and/or stay later to assist with getting their horse prepared (no additional charge). I'm looking forward to assisting you through your horsemanship journey!

EQUIPMENT:

When riding, appropriate riding boots are required. Sneakers will not be permitted. Riding helmets are required while riding. These will be initially provided; however, you are expected to purchase your own riding helmet once you have completed at least one session of riding lessons. Riding jeans or breeches are required when riding. An additional list of other clothes will be provided if you choose to ride during the Winter Session.
